

A Simple Guide to Painting Drumsticks



1. First, you will need the paint and a lacquer.



2. Next, you'll want to tape the beads and any other part of the stick you do not want painted.



3. To paint the sticks, I hung them from a hook with twine on my porch. You may have a better method.



4. I applied 2 coats of paint, then 2 coats of lacquer, allowing each coat to fully dry.

5. The finished product.



6. For comparison, the sticks on the left I purchased already painted. The sticks on the right I painted.

And that's it. Pretty simple right? The stick logos were not fully covered by the paint but no one is going to notice that from a distance. Of course, you can always apply additional coats of paint if you like, but I wasn't trying to spend a lot of money on this. Hope this has helped and good luck!
